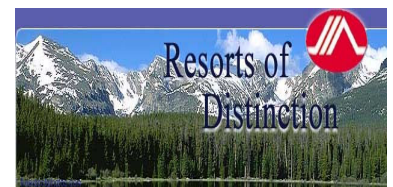

NEWS AND UPDATES

Our wonderful staff includes: Bill our Facility Manager; Ed our Chef and Activities Coordinator; Jon and Carrie in Accounting; Shane and Travis in Maintenance; Mike and Justin in Security; Lori and Karen in Marketing. We welcome our three new staff members: Debbie in Reservations, Ashley in Housekeeping and Tom as an HRR Park Representative.

We have upgraded the wireless internet service at the resort by bringing in two high speed T1 internet service lines. That means much faster speeds and no bandwidth limitations. To offset our increased cost to bring this improved service to you, a nominal fee of \$10 per week will be charged for those who use the internet. We also intend to add a range extender to boost the service further out into the park.

DUTCH OVEN PIE RECIPE

Required: aluminum foil or aluminum pie tin

Ingredients:

1 can apple pie filling

1 box Jiffy muffin mix

1/4 stick butter

1 spray can of whipped cream

Directions: Pour the filling into the pie tin. Sprinkle the dry muffin mix over the entire surface. Slice the butter into thin squares and distribute across surface. Put 4 or 5 equal sized pebbles in the dutch oven. (keeping the tin off the bottom reduces burning.) Put on the lid and cover with coals. Cook for 10 to 15 minutes, depending on

fire temperature. Dish a spoonful out and apply whipped cream. Notes: Replace apple filling with any of your choice. Try different types of muffin mix for variations. Some people stir the muffin mix into the filling. Use fresh fruit instead of canned fruit.



PARK INFORMATION AND RULES

Park rules: 5mph speed limit in the park; we enforce it.

Max 8 persons per site and 2 vehicles per site.

If you have hot ashes or coals or ashes or coals left over from a fire or BBQ, let us know and we will be happy to dispose of them for you.

Please do not leave your campsite unattended for more than 24 hours. If you do plan on leaving overnight, notify our security or front office.

10pm is quiet time.

We have several garbage cans throughout the park. If a can is overflowing use the adjacent can or let us know and we will come pick it up for you.



Please do not park on our lawns, we take pride in our beautiful landscape. Park in designated areas only. Thanks!

Pool and Spa hours: 9am to 10pm unless otherwise posted. You must be 14 years or older to use the pool or be accompanied by an adult.

Recreational equipment: May be checked out at the front office.

Reservations: Monday—Saturday 8:30am—4:30pm. Check in at 2pm— Check out at 11am. 48-hour reservation cancellation policy; please call in advance to avoid a charge. A credit card is needed for all reservations. Rentals require a minimum 2-night stay. *Got linens?* Remember to bring your linens and towels when staying in a rental unit. Due to ever changing winter weather conditions, access and hours may change.

Pets: Keep pets on a leash and out of all buildings. Please pick up after your pets.
