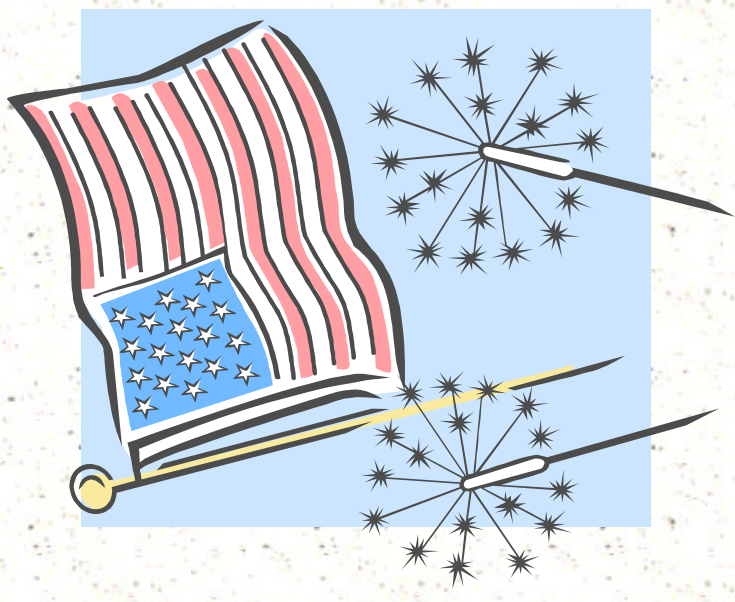

RESERVATION REMINDERS

Have your member number ready when making reservations. Check in at 2pm—Check out at 11am. There is a 48-hour reservation cancellation policy; please call in advance to avoid a \$25 charge. **A credit card is required for all reservations.** Rentals require a minimum 2-night stay. No more than 2 reservations on the books at any given time. You may call within 7days prior to the date of stay and reserve additional sites upon availability; additional rates do apply.

Important reminder: *A credit card on file is required if you are attending the Special BBQ events (see reverse). You also will need to call and get on the BBQ list and pre-pay at least 72 hours prior to the event date. Refunds on cancellations of special events are not allowed if the cancellation occurs within 24 hours of the event date. This policy helps ensure that we have plenty of food on hand with a minimum going to waste. Thank you!!*



Speed limit of 5 MPH is strictly enforced for your safety.

Pets: Keep pets on a leash and out of all buildings. Please pick up after your pets; there is a nominal fee if mess is not picked up.

Scott Flat Lake gate passes are available for Harmony Ridge Resort members only and are located in the front office. A refundable \$20 deposit is required before checking out a lake pass. Passes need to be returned the same day they are checked out.

We have several garbage cans throughout the park. If a can is over flowing use the adjacent can or let us know, and we will come pick it up for you.

Recreational equipment: May be checked out at the front office by giving your site or rental number. Scooters and skateboards are not allowed in the resort because they can reach speeds that are not suitable for them, making it unsafe. When riding your bicycle please wear a helmet.

Max 8 persons per site and **2 vehicles** per site. Check with security before using a fire pit. If you have hot ashes or coals left over from a fire or BBQ, let us know and we will be happy to dispose of them for you.

Please do not leave your campsite unattended for more than 24 hours. If you do plan on leaving overnight, notify our security or front office. 10pm is quiet time. We appreciate that you don't share your loud music with everyone. Barking dogs and unleashed dogs will be asked to leave the park.



Pool and Spa hours: 9am to 10pm unless otherwise posted. You must be 14 years or older to use the pool or be accompanied by an adult.

Late check-ins: call to notify us if you are arriving after 10pm.

Trailhead: North Bloomfield Road or Malakoff Campground. Parking.
Directions: From Nevada City, Hwy. 49 north to Tyler-Foote Crossing Road, then right (east) to Malakoff Diggins. Distance Of Hike: 3 miles
Degree Of Difficulty: 6.
Seasons: Year-round. Some snow in Winter.
Historical Significance: Views of the Malakoff hydraulic diggings.
Special Features: Pine and cedar forests. Pets Must be leashed.

DIGGINS LOOP TRAIL

Trailhead: Diggins Overlook, North Bloomfield Road. Parking.
Distance Of Hike: 3 mile loop.
Degree Of Difficulty: 3.
Seasons: Year-round. Some snow in Winter.
Historical Significance: Trail loops through what was once the largest hydraulic mining operation in the U.S. Happy Trails!
